

Lincoln Parking

Important information

Do not park at a parking meter. You will not have an opportunity to move your vehicle throughout the day, and the court cannot reimburse parking fines.

Pay attention to clearance levels in the parking garages and garage signage.
The court is not liable for theft of property or damage to vehicles.

Federal parking garage

Limited visitor parking is available in the federal parking garage located directly south of the Denney Federal Building, between “O” and “N” Streets. Enter the visitor parking area from “O” Street or “N” Street. Visitors may park only in spaces 1-55, which include 4 handicapped spaces. All other parking spaces in the garage are reserved. Do not park in any other space because your car may be towed.

If you park in the visitor parking, you must log your vehicle in the record book near the security station on first floor of the federal building. The log will ask you what agency you are visiting. Please write US Courts.

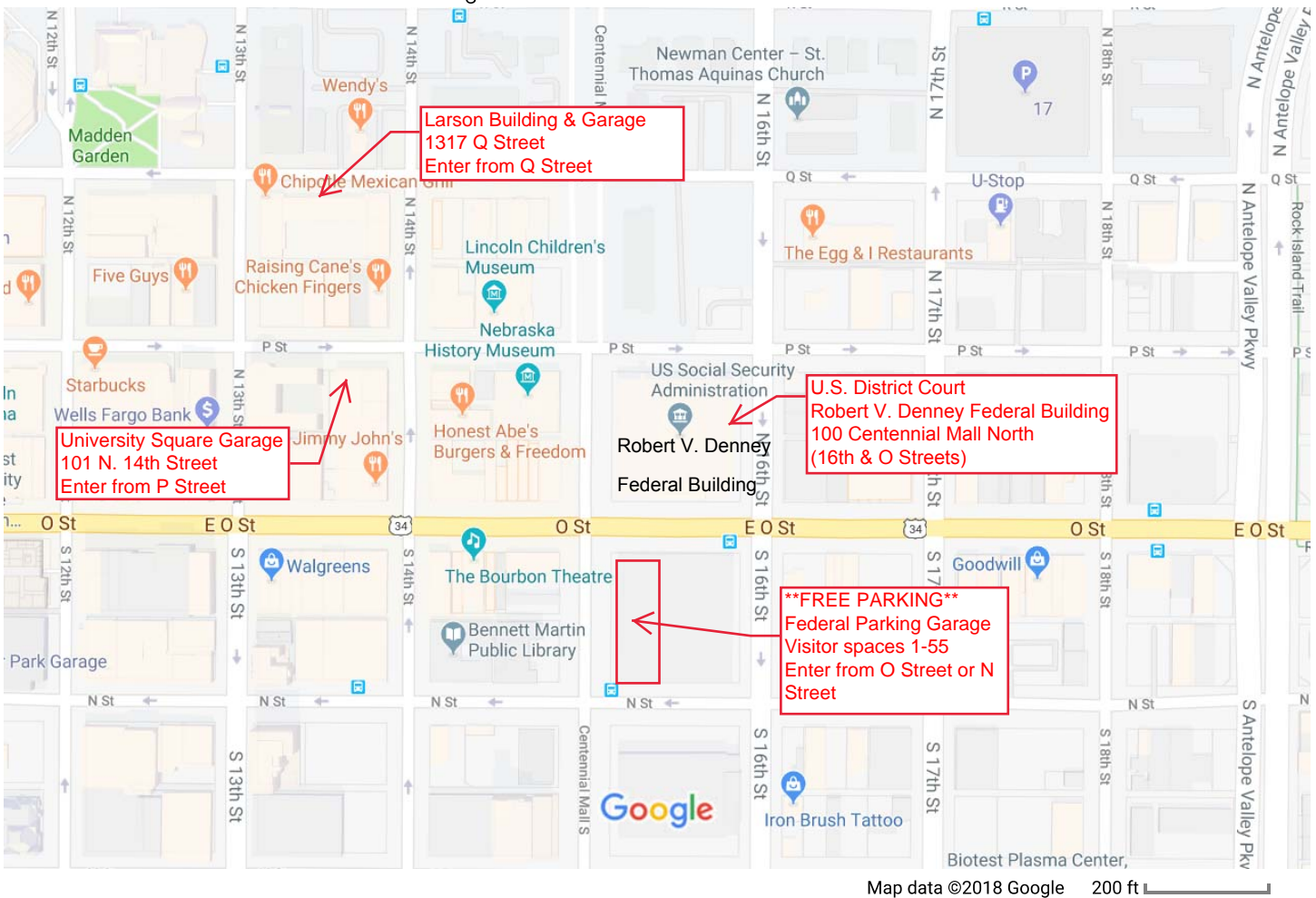
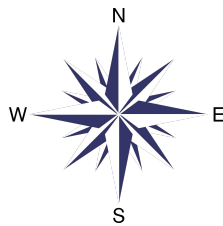

If visitor parking is full in the federal parking garage, there are parking facilities within walking distance of the Denney Federal Building such as **University Square Garage** and **Larson Building & Garage** (see map on back). The court will reimburse you for reasonable parking fees.

If you park in one of these facilities, you will need to pay when you exit. When an attendant is at the pay station, you may pay with cash or Visa or Mastercard. When no attendant is at the pay station, you must pay with a Visa or Mastercard. Attendants are usually on duty from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
