General Order No. 2011-07

The Committee on Court Administration and Case Management (CACM) of the Judicial Conference of the United States, in consultation with the Federal Judicial Center, has selected the District Court of Nebraska to participate in a pilot program established by the Judicial Conference in September 2010 (JCUS-SEP 10, pp. 3-4) to study the use of cameras in district courtrooms.

During this pilot, there will be a limited exception to the ban found in Nebraska General Rule 1.6(f) and (g) on recording and publication of district court proceedings for district judges participating in the program. Any recording and broadcasting conducted pursuant to the pilot program must comply with the program guidelines issued by the CACM, available at <http://www.uscourts.gov/uscourts/News/2011/docs/CamerasGuidelines.pdf>.
