In the event the Federal Public Defender should decline this appointment in a specific case because of a conflict of interest or on the basis of the Amended Criminal Justice Act Plan, the Federal Public Defender shall forthwith provide the court with a draft appointment order (CJA Form 20) bearing the name and other identifying information of the CJA Panel attorney identified in accordance with the Amended Criminal Justice Act Plan for this district. In the event the Federal Public Defender, or CJA Panel attorney, becomes aware of information indicating the defendant is financially able to retain counsel, the Federal Public Defender or CJA Panel attorney shall notify the court of the financial circumstances of the defendant.
