Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title 18, U.S.C. §3006A(a)(1) and (c), and because of the need to process petitions under <u>Johnson v. United States</u>, 135 S. Ct. 2551 (2015), efficiently,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Federal Public Defender for the District of Nebraska or one of his delegates under the Criminal Justice Act is herewith appointed to represent any defendant who was previously determined to have been entitled to appointment of counsel, or who is now indigent, to determine whether that defendant may qualify for federal habeas relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in light of <u>Johnson</u>, and to present any petitions, motions or applications relating thereto to the Court for disposition.

The United States Probation Office is authorized to release to the Federal Public Defender the presentence investigation reports and statement of reasons in such cases.

The Defendant, through counsel, is granted leave to file an amended motion under 28 U.S.C. §2255 on or before the earlier of (1) thirty days after the entry of this Order on the docket, or (2) July 25, 2016.
