The Omaha civil cases reassigned to Chief Judge Kopf will also be reassigned to Magistrate Judge Piester, and it is the intention of Judge Kopf to transfer these Omaha cases to the Lincoln docket. Judge Kopf will not transfer North Platte cases to the Lincoln docket.

(5) The Clerk shall mail copies of this order to all counsel of record in these cases.
