GENERAL ORDER
NO. 99- 6

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2518(8)(a),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

(1) Except as otherwise directed by the issuing judge, the recordings of the contents of any wire, oral, or electronic communication recorded under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 2518 shall, immediately upon the expiration of the period of the interception order, or extensions thereof, be made available to the issuing judge and sealed pursuant to this general order;

(2) The recordings may be delivered personally to the issuing judge or to the Clerk of the United States District Court, or his or her Chief Deputy. Thereafter, custody of the recordings shall be maintained by the Clerk of the United States District Court. In the presence of the issuing judge, the Clerk of the Court, or the Chief Deputy Clerk of Court, the recordings shall be sealed by placing them in a box and sealing the box with tape or other sealant. The issuing judge, the Clerk of the Court, or the Chief Deputy Clerk of the Court, shall place his or her initials on the box or boxes that are sealed together with the date that the boxes were sealed and the approximate time of sealing;


(3) While in the custody of the Clerk of the Court, the recordings shall be kept in a secure facility in such a manner as to protect the recordings from editing or other alterations.




