This court's General Order of August 5, 1986, as modified by any subsequent order, is hereby superseded in its entirety as follows:

FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL
FOR THE DISTRICT OF NEBRASKA

1. Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 58(d), an accused may pay a fixed sum, i.e., forfeit collateral, in lieu of an appearance before a United States magistrate judge for certain scheduled offenses committed within the territorial and subject matter jurisdiction of the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska. The schedules of offenses and the amounts to be forfeited are set forth on the attached schedules. Such schedules may be modified by general order of the court in accordance with Fed. R. Crim. P. 58(d)(1).

2. This order shall apply only to those offenses as set forth on the attached schedules or any subsequent modifications thereto and only to those proceedings which are commenced by a citation or violation notice issued by a law enforcement officer authorized to issue such citation or violation notice. If the offense results in serious personal injury, death, or property damage in excess of \$1,000, the accused must appear before a magistrate judge on the citation or violation notice. If the appropriate schedule reflects that a mandatory appearance (M.A.) before a magistrate judge is required, the citation or violation notice shall so indicate and the accused may not post collateral in lieu of an appearance. If the circumstances surrounding the charged offense are aggravated, the issuing law enforcement officer, in his or her discretion, may require a mandatory appearance before the magistrate judge.

3. Upon the timely payment of the amount set forth in the attached schedules, the proceedings initiated by the citation or violation notice shall be terminated.

4. Nothing in this order shall preclude the United States from initiating a

prosecution for any of the scheduled offenses by means of a complaint, information, or indictment.

5. The clerical, administrative and fiscal operations necessary for the administration of the collateral forfeiture system shall be conducted by the Clerk of this Court and the Consolidated Central Violations Bureaus operated under the laws of the United States and the regulations established by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.

(a) The Chief, each Regional Forester, each Experiment Station Director, the Administrator of the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit and each Forest Supervisor may issue orders which close or restrict the use of described areas within the area over which he has jurisdiction. An order may close an area to entry or may restrict the use of an area by applying any or all of the prohibitions authorized in this subpart or any portion thereof.

(b) The Chief, each Regional Forester, each Experiment Station Director, the Administration of the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit and each Forest Supervisor may issue orders which close or restrict the use of any forest development road or trail within the area over which he has jurisdiction.

(c) Each order shall:

(1) For orders issued under paragraph (a) of this section, describe the area to which the order applies;

(2) For orders issued under paragraph (b) of this section, describe the road or trail to which the order applies;

(3) Specify the times during which the prohibitions apply if applied only during limited times.

(4) State each prohibition which is applied; and

(5) Be posted in accordance with Section 261.51.

(d) The prohibitions which are applied by an order are supplemental to the general prohibitions in Subpart A.

(e) An order may exempt any of the following persons from any of the prohibitions contained in the order:

(1) Persons with a special use authorization specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(2) Any other person meeting exemption requirements specified in the order.

(f) Any person wishing to use a forest development road or trail or a portion of the National Forest System, should contact the Forest Supervisor, Director, Administrator, or District Ranger to ascertain the special restriction which may be applicable thereto.
