Alito, Jr. of the United States Supreme Court; Professor Lawrence Lessig, Director of the Edmond J. Safra Center for Ethics at Harvard University; Dean Erwin Chemerinsky of the University of California, Irvine School of Law; and Gregory P. Joseph of Joseph Hage Aaronson, LLC, New York. In recognition of the 50th anniversary of the 1964 Civil Rights Act, our Conference luncheon speaker will be President and Director–Counsel of the NAACP Legal Defense and Education Fund, Sherrilyn Ifill. The Eighth Circuit luncheon will include presentation of the American Inns of Court Award and the Richard S. Arnold Awards for Distinguished Service and Lifetime Achievement.
