

47.1 Jury Pool Questionnaires.

- (a) Standard Jury Questionnaire.** The clerk submits questionnaires to potential jury pool members. Parties and their attorneys may not obtain completed questionnaires, and they are not available for review without a court order. A list of potential jurors is available to attorneys and parties before trial and may only be used for jury selection. No information on the list may be released to the public.
- (b) Additional Questionnaire for a Specific Case.** The trial judge may determine sua sponte or upon motion that a particular case's circumstances justify submitting additional questions to prospective jury pool members. In the interest of securing a fair and impartial trial, the judge may (1) ask the parties to assist in drafting additional questions and (2) require the submission of additional written questions to potential jury pool members.
