





conditions of release. 8 C.F.R. §§236.1 and 3.19.

8. A noncitizen should receive a bond hearing within a reasonable time after asserting his right to such a hearing.

9. In Matter of Spiliopoulos, 16 I&N 561 (BIA 1978), the BIA recognized employment history, length of residence, family ties, absence of criminal history and absence of immigration violations as bond factors because they are indicators of whether a person is likely to appear. In Matter of Leon-Perez, 15 I&N 235 (BIA 1975), the BIA held that eligibility for relief from deportation was also a bond factor. Respondent has a meritorious application for bond in which Respondent will demonstrate to the Court his eligibility for relief from removal and other equities which warrant either releasing on recognizance or redetermination of bond to an amount within Respondent's means.

10. If Respondent continues to be detained without opportunity for a hearing to demonstrate the appropriateness of setting a bond necessary to assure Respondent's appearance at future proceedings, Respondent will suffer a deprivation of liberty in being detained without cause. Respondent's ability to promptly and effectively defend the charges will also be delayed and prejudiced.

WHEREFORE, Respondent moves that a bond hearing be scheduled before an Immigration Judge at the earliest available time.

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT I

On or about December 4, 2012, in the District of Nebraska, the defendant, *Slippery Pete* defendant herein, a name fully known to the Grand Jury, with intent to deceive, falsely represented a number to be the Social Security account number assigned by the Commissioner of Social Security to him, when in fact such number, ending in *XXX-XX-1423* is not the Social Security account number assigned by the commissioner of Social Security to him, for purposes of obtaining any benefit to which he is not entitled and for any other purpose, to wit: to satisfy a requirement of section 274A(b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

In violation of Title 42, United States Code, Section 408(a)(7)(B), and subject to sentencing under Title 18.

COUNT II

Between on or about January 1, 2010, and up to and including December 14, 2012, in the District of Nebraska, defendant *Slippery Pete*, knowing and in reckless disregard of the fact that an alien, to wit: *Marcelo Reyes* had come to, entered, and remained in the United States in violation of law, did conceal, harbor, and shield from detection such alien in any place for the purpose of commercial advantage and private financial gain, to wit: by providing *Marcelo Reyes* false names and Social Security account numbers for the purpose of the employing *Marcelo Reyes* with *ECSSanitation Management, Inc.*, in exchange for which cash payments were made by *Marcelo Reyes* to defendant *Slippery Pete*.



In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1324(a)(1)(A)(iii).

COUNT III

Between on or about January 1, 2011, and up to and including December 14, 2012, in the District of Nebraska, defendant *Slippery Pete*, knowing and in reckless disregard of the fact that an alien, to wit: *magic mike*, had come to, entered, and remained in the United States in violation of law, did conceal, harbor, and shield from detection such alien in any place for the purpose of commercial advantage and private financial gain, to wit: by providing *magic mike* false names and Social Security account numbers for the purpose of the employing Alfredo Franco-Montoya with DCS Sanitation Management, Inc., in exchange for which a cash payment was made by Alfredo Franco-Montoya to defendant *Slippery Pete*.


In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1324(a)(1)(A)(iii).

**DEFENDANT HISTORY**

Pretrial Services interviewed *Slippery Pete* in the U.S. Marshal's holding cell on *Jan. 1, 2013*. After being read the "Notice to Defendant" form, the defendant waived the right to consult with counsel prior to giving consent to this interview. The assistance of an interpreter, *Mark Garcia-Paz*, was necessary to communicate with this defendant.

Immigration and Customs Enforcement have filed a detainer with the U.S. Marshals for *Slippery Pete*. A copy of this detainer is attached to this report.

Pretrial Services attempted to contact the defendant's wife *Jane Pete* however no answer was received. Therefore, the information in this report has not been verified, except where noted.

**1. DEFENDANT HISTORY / RESIDENCE / FAMILY TIES:**

*Slippery Pete* age 53 reported he was born in Mexico, where he resided until 1996, when he moved to the United States. Mr. *Pete* advised he remained in the United States until late 2011, when he returned to Mexico for approximately two months. In early, 2012, the defendant stated he returned to the United States, and has resided in the U.S. since that time. Specifically, Mr. *Pete* reported he has resided at the above noted address with his wife *Jane Pete* for approximately 13 years. He indicated he has resided in *Omaha, Nebraska*, at various residences, for the past 15 years. The defendant further advised he has resided in *Omaha, Nebraska* for 9 months and *Ottawa, Iowa* for 2 months.

The defendant reported his parents are *Juvelto, Diaz Masq* and *Maria del Orto* both of Mexico. He noted he speaks with his parents, by telephone, approximately every three days. Mr. *Pete* indicated he has 6 siblings who reside in Mexico, whom he maintains

regular contact with. He further noted he has three siblings who reside in Omaha, Nebraska: Maria Luna Pete; Victor Pete and Janet Pete. The defendant advised he also has nieces and nephews who reside in the Omaha area.

Mr. Pete stated he was previously married for "five or eight" years to Maria Sarica, who currently resides in Mexico. He noted the couple are divorced, however noted that his "papers" were stolen, and his name is legally married to another individual in Mexico, however he is not currently married. The defendant reported he had one child from his prior marriage; Jesus (12), and that his son resides in Mexico with his mother.

The defendant indicated he has been in a relationship with Jane Pete for the past 15 years. He stated the couple have no children together. He advised Jane is employed full-time with Good Foods in Omaha, Nebraska.

## 2. EMPLOYMENT HISTORY / FINANCIAL RESOURCES:

Mr. Pete reported he completed the 6<sup>th</sup> grade while attending school in Mexico. He has not attended any further education since that time.

Due to the nature of the offense, Pretrial Services did not question the defendant about employment history. Information regarding financial resources is unavailable.

## 3. HEALTH

Mr. Pete reported he suffers from high cholesterol, and has been prescribed medication for this health issue. He noted he has been taking this medication for approximately 5 years. The defendant stated he has never participated in mental health counseling, or been prescribed medication for a mental health condition.

The defendant reported he "used to" consume alcohol on a regular basis, however advised he has not consumed any alcohol for 12 years. Mr. Pete indicated he has never tried marijuana, heroin, cocaine, PCP, LSD, ecstasy, methamphetamine, or any other illicit substance in his life.

## 4. PRIOR RECORD: The records of NCIC/NCIS, and the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles were accessed to compile the following criminal record of: Slippery Pete, DOB 09101/59

Additional Information:

According to the Law Enforcement Support Center database, *Slippery Pete* is a citizen of Mexico. The defendant was legally admitted to the United States on December 31, Year Unknown (Listed as 9999) as a non-immigrant for a limited amount of time. Records indicate the defendant departed the United States pm . Records note that if the defendant has remained longer in the U.S. without permission, they may be in violation of immigration laws. Furthermore, if a departure date is listed, no new record of legal entry into the United States has been granted.

**5. ASSESSMENT OF NON-APPEARANCE:**

The defendant poses a risk of nonappearance due to the following reasons:

- Citizen of a foreign country.
- Lack of employment ties to the community.
- Offense charged.
- Use of aliases or false identification.

**6. ASSESSMENT OF DANGER:**

The defendant poses a risk of danger to the community due to the following reasons:

- Offense charged.

**7. RECOMMENDATION:**

Pretrial Services considers the defendant to pose risks of nonappearance and danger to the community. It appears there is no condition or combination of conditions which will reasonably assure the defendant's appearance in court or the safety of the community. At your hearing you will be given the opportunity to admit or deny any or all of the allegations in the Notice to Appear and that you are inadmissible or removable on the charges contained in the Notice to Appear. You will have an opportunity to present evidence on your own behalf, to examine any evidence presented by the Government, to object, on proper legal grounds, to the receipt of evidence and to cross examine any witnesses presented by the Government. At the conclusion of your hearing, you have a right to appeal an adverse decision by the immigration judge.

You will be advised by the immigration judge before whom you appear of any relief from removal for which you may appear eligible including the privilege of departure voluntarily. You will be given a reasonable opportunity to make any such application to the immigration judge.

Failure to appear: You are required to provide the DHS, in writing, with your full mailing address and telephone number. You must notify the Immigration Court immediately by using Form EOIR-33 whenever you change your address or telephone number during the course of this proceeding. You will be provided with a copy of this form. Notices of hearing will be mailed to this address. If you do not submit Form EOIR-33 and do not otherwise provide an address at which you may be reached during proceedings, then the Government shall not be required to provide you with written notice of your hearing. If you fail to attend the hearing at the time and place designated on this notice, or any date and time later directed by the Immigration Court, a removal order may be made by the immigration judge in your absence, and you may be arrested and detained by the DHS.

Mandatory Duty to Surrender for Removal: If you become subject to a final order of removal, you must surrender for removal to one of the offices listed in 8 CFR 241.16(a). Specific addresses on locations for surrender can be obtained from your local DHS office or over the internet at http://www.ice.gov/about/dro/contact.htm. You must surrender within 30 days from the date the order becomes administratively final, unless you obtain an order from a Federal court, immigration court, or the Board of Immigration Appeals staying execution of the removal order. Immigration regulations at 8 CFR 241.1 define when the removal order becomes administratively final. If you are granted voluntary departure and fail to depart the United States as required, fail to post a bond in connection with voluntary departure, or fail to comply with any other condition or term in connection with voluntary departure, you must surrender for removal on the next business day thereafter. If you do not surrender for removal as required, you will be ineligible for all forms of discretionary relief for as long as you remain in the United States and for ten years after departure or removal. This means you will be ineligible for asylum, cancellation of removal, voluntary departure, adjustment of status, change of nonimmigrant status, registry, and related waivers for this period. If you do not surrender for removal as required, you may also be criminally prosecuted under section 243 of the Act.

Request for Prompt Hearing

To expedite a determination in my case, I request an immediate hearing. I waive my right to a 10-day period prior to appearing before an immigration judge.

Before

[REDACTED] R/O's YOUNG, Forever2013 and GUTIERREZ, G1 [REDACTED] were dispatched to [REDACTED] for the report of a property damage accident involving a Dodge Neon and an silver vehicle.

Upon arriving, R/O's met with one of the drivers involved ROBERTS, Mike (04/23/65) who advised he was traveling eastbound on Leavenworth [REDACTED] when a vehicle pulled out in front of him in an attempt to do a U-turn and collided with [REDACTED] car. R/O then made contact with the second involved driver, who stated he didn't speak English. R/O's requested in Spanish the male's license and were handed an Acapulco, Mexico driver's license with the name Pete, Slippery with a date of birth of [REDACTED]. R/O attempted a data check using the name last ALMEDA, Francisco initially and could not locate a record on the male. He advised R/O's that he lived at 5525 Happy St apartment number 1, which was the same address as the registered owner of the vehicle. R/O's then attempted a data check using Pete, Slippery with a date of birth of [REDACTED]. On NCIC R/O's had a record come back for [REDACTED] (R/O's noted the "s" in this spelling of Francisco as opposed to the "c") that was suspended driving and had the date of birth 11/21/84. In IMS, R/O located a record for Pete, Slippery living at 5525 Happy Blvd apartment #3 that had a misdemeanor warrant. R/O's asked the male again for his address and if he had ever been arrested in Omaha and the male repeated 5525 Happy St. and stated he had never been arrested in Omaha. R/O's then asked what the male's date of birth was and he stated several times that he was born in the month of April in 1986 but didn't know the day he was born. The male's wife and other family members arrived on the scene of the accident and R/O questioned the male's wife with the help of another family member to translate. When asked where the male lived R/O was advised that he lived at 1015 Turner Blvd apartment 3. She also advised that her husband had been arrested before and that he had reported his vehicle stolen approximately four months ago and had taken a Police report. R/O asked the female what her husband's date of birth was and she stated she didn't know and hadn't been with him that long. R/O looked at the past history of Pete, Slippery in IMS that had an outstanding warrant and observed that in [REDACTED] he was the victim of reported criminal mischief and theft unlawful taking. Based on the male not knowing his day of birth, the past record lining up with the wife's statements of reporting incidents to Police and being told by the wife that the male lived in apartment 3 which matched the address of the male with the outstanding warrant R/O's decided to transport the male to Central Headquarters for a fingerprint identification check.

R/O's completed the fingerprint check with the assistance of front desk personnel and discovered that the male's fingerprints were on file under the name Pete, Slippery. R/O's retrieved a mugshot of Pete, Slippery and confirmed it was the male in custody and also that Pete [REDACTED] ZO had two outstanding warrants through the Douglas County Sheriff. R/O's booked Pete [REDACTED] into corrections for criminal impersonation, driving during suspension, illegal u-turn and the two outstanding warrants.
