

## **Admission to Practice Pro Hac Vice**

The rules governing admission for a particular case (pro hac vice) are set forth in [NEGenR 1.7\(f\)](#). If you would like to be admitted to practice pro hac vice in the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska and this is the first time you are requesting to be admitted, go to [www.pacer.gov](http://www.pacer.gov):

- Click on REGISTER
- Click on Attorney Filers

Complete the on-screen instructions. Note that you may leave the Additional Filer Information section blank.

Upon receipt of your admission request, the court will review your request and provide further filing instructions via e-mail. Upon receipt of the e-mail from the court, you will log in to <http://www.ned.uscourts.gov/attorney/cmecf-login> and file the applicable pro hac vice motion.

### **Your pro hac vice motion must include the following information:**

- Case number for which you are requesting admission.
- Oath of Admission set forth in [NEGenR 1.7\(e\)](#).
- State bar to which you are currently admitted as required by [NEGenR 1.7\(f\)](#).

Note: If you were previously admitted to the court pro hac vice and you received a CM/ECF login and password, you only need to link your account (if you have not already done so) using the following instructions:

Once your account is linked, you may file the motion to be admitted pro hac vice in the appropriate case and pay the filing fee.
