
Juror Coronavirus (COVID-19) Questionnaire

The U.S. District Court for the District of Nebraska is carefully monitoring the evolving circumstances presented by the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) disease and the new developments which impact jurors summoned by the court.

You should know how important your service is to the courts and to the administration of justice. Please be assured that the court has implemented safety measures to encourage social distancing and protect the health of jurors in the courthouse.

As part of our efforts to minimize exposure, we request that you review the following questions. If you answer “yes” to any of the questions **at any point during your jury service**, please contact the jury clerk as noted below as soon as possible. The court will postpone your service if you fall within any of the categories.

1. Over the past 14 days have you or has anyone in your household developed flu-like symptoms such as cough, fever, or shortness of breath?
2. To the best of your knowledge, have you been in close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
3. Do you have a serious underlying medical condition that makes you at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19?
4. Does anyone in your household have a serious underlying medical condition that makes him or her at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19?
5. Are you a healthcare worker directly involved with the treatment of COVID-19?

For all other jurors who do not fall into any of the categories above, please remain available to serve, unless you are eligible to postpone your service for other reasons or hardships.
