**GENERAL ORDER 2005-19**

**IT IS ORDERED:**

Effective immediately, the Clerk of Court is authorized to enter orders striking PDF documents filed on the court's Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system for the following reasons:

1. The document is a duplicate of another document already filed on the system in the same case;
2. The document is filed in the wrong case;
3. The document is empty or incomplete; or
4. The document is upside down or illegible.

The Clerk will docket these strike orders in a text-only format; no PDF document will be attached. The order will indicate whether the filing party will be required to file a replacement document.

A party who disputes the Clerk's decision to strike a document may move to have the assigned judge set aside the strike order.
