The Bankruptcy Judges of this district and the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court have drafted proposed amendments to the local bankruptcy rules. All of the attorneys registered on the electronic case filing system for the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nebraska have received a request for comment of the proposed draft. The comments which were received were included in the final draft.

The final date for comments has expired.

The Bankruptcy Judges have determined that the proposed amended rules are consistent with, but not duplicative of Acts of Congress and do not prohibit or limit the use of Official Forms. In addition, the Bankruptcy Judges have determined that the proposed amended local rules do conform to the uniform numbering system prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States for Bankruptcy Rules. The Bankruptcy Judges do now recommend to the United States District Court that the final draft of the rules submitted to the United States District Court on December 27, 2007, should be adopted by the District Court pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the proposed amended rules of the Bankruptcy Court as submitted to the District Court are adopted.

The amended Nebraska Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure are effective as of January 25, 2008, subject only to review by the Judicial Council of the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals.
