GENERAL ORDER NO. 2021-02

Given the ongoing local and national emergency occasioned by the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic, and after consultation with the United States Attorney and the Federal Public Defender for the District of Nebraska,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The continuances implemented by General Order 2020-14, General Order 2020-15, and General Order 2020-16 are extended to include all proceedings set to begin on or before February 15, 2021. Jury trials may commence on Tuesday, February 16, 2021.
- 2. For the reasons stated in General Order 2020-04, General Order 2020-14, and General Order 2020-16, the delays in progression of criminal cases occasioned by the continuances implemented by this General Order are excluded under the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A) & (B)(iii). The period between November 2, 2020 and February 15, 2021 is excluded when computing the time limitations specified in § 3161 for all pending criminal cases. The failure of any defendant to object to this General Order will be deemed a waiver of any right to later claim the time should not have been excluded under the Speedy Trial Act.
