
**GENERAL ORDER

CM/ECF filing for the District of Nebraska will suspend operation at 8:00 p.m. on Friday, June 2, 2023. After 8:00 p.m. on Friday, June 2, 2023, Notices of Electronic Filing will not issue until CM/ECF becomes operational on Sunday, June 4, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. An extension for electronic filing will be granted for all documents with court-imposed deadlines falling between 8:00 p.m. on June, 2, 2023, and midnight on Friday, June 2, 2023. All such documents must be filed on or before Monday, June 5, 2023.

The Clerk will accept documents via email during CM/ECF suspension, if sent to [clerk@ned.uscourts.gov](mailto:clerk@ned.uscourts.gov). Such submissions should be limited to filings with a statute of limitations deadline, requests for emergency injunctive relief, notices of appeal, and similar time-sensitive filings. If counsel or pro se filers have any concern about whether a filing must be submitted to the Clerk to ensure its timeliness, they should submit the filing by email. Documents submitted by email will be deemed filed as of the date received and will be entered on the docket by the Clerk's Office as soon as practical.
